“As a PA I always wanted to give my patients as much information as possible about their condition and how it might be evaluated and treated as well as how it might affect their lives going forward. Unfortunately this takes time and time is a luxury that most medical providers no longer have available to them.”

As a PA I have practiced in many settings. The bulk of my experience is in adult family/internal medicine. Because I have mostly been in rural areas, I've had to be all things to my patients. I've treated conditions that would have been handed off to specialists had I been in a large city. I've interpreted all kinds of diagnostic studies including labs, imaging, and specialized studies. I have enjoyed my career in medicine but ultimately I was faced with the reality that I could no longer practice medicine in what I felt was the best benefit for my patients. I just could not see someone for 5-10 minutes and walk away. Human beings are just too complex for that. I am now retired as a PA.

Because of the number of people at a loss for information about their health, I want to offer the opportunity to have that discussion that is so often skipped in these busy times. I can review labs, imaging, medications, supplements, medical history, etc. and explain to you what it all means and what that may imply. If your doctors keep telling you the same thing over and over but you don't know why, I can shed light on the why behind those comments.

In my visits, the environment is relaxed and private. You can bring someone with you if you'd like. No question is silly. I trained hard to be able to participate in this very complex field. Medical providers do this so you don't have to. You are not expected to know what all those 4 syllable words mean, that's what I'm here for!

Most visits will take about 30-60 minutes, but I will not run you out the door at 60 minutes. You are in control. We will stick to the topics you choose. You can decide when to stop the visit. In some very complex cases, it may be beneficial to break things up into multiple visits to avoid information overload. We can figure all this out together.

I charge on 15 minute intervals at \$15 per interval. For example, a 55 minute visit would be a \$60 charge since it involves four 15 minute intervals.
